



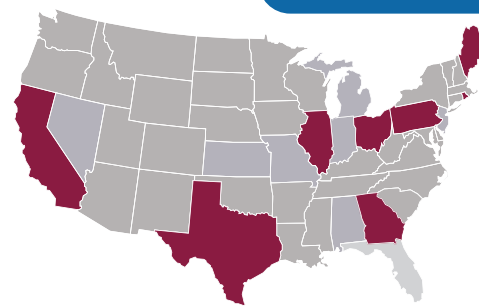

2022 California University of Science and Medicine Inaugural Class of MD Students

- » The Prime Healthcare Foundation founded the **California University of Science and Medicine** in 2018 to train the next generation of physicians to serve disadvantaged communities in California and throughout the world. The university, located in San Bernardino County, graduated its inaugural class of MD students in May 2022.
- » Prime Healthcare Foundation hospitals have received **numerous safety awards, accolades and recognition** from organizations including Healthgrades, Premier, The Leapfrog Group, CMS, American Heart Association/American Stroke Association, and more.
- » In 2025, Prime Healthcare and Prime Healthcare Foundation hospitals were recognized as the "**most socially responsible**" by the Lown Institute. Prime earned "**A**" grades in key categories including Social Responsibility, Health Equity, Patient Outcomes, Clinical Outcomes, and Inclusivity. Of the 46 hospitals evaluated, 28 (approximately 61%) received an "**A**" grade for outstanding social responsibility on the 2025-26 Lown Institute Hospitals Index.
- » Prime Healthcare Foundation and Prime Healthcare received the prestigious 2021 John M. Eisenberg Patient Safety and Quality Award in the "**National Level Innovation in Patient Safety and Quality**" category. Prime was recognized for its cohesive program in groundbreaking initiatives in social determinants of health that are consistent with the aims of the National Quality Strategy: better care, healthy people and communities, and smarter spending.
